Dear Fathers and Parish Leaders,

Recently I had a meeting with Sherry Fleming of Nova Scotians United for Life and she asked for our support in creating a culture of life throughout our parishes. I believe that the pro-life work of Nova Scotians United for Life (NSUL) is aligned with our Catholic mission and mandate and can result in good fruit for the faithful.

I encourage your parish to collaborate with NSUL to meet the needs of the faithful including but not limited to the following items:

1. Approval to have NSUL and Project Rachel website links and events on parish websites, Facebook and other social media pages, calendars and bulletins/newsletters, and to promote Project Rachel - a 10 week post abortion healing program.
2. Approval for NSUL and Project Rachel to display poster, brochures, and pre Mass slide in parishes to encourage parishioner participation in pro-life programs and events.
3. Approval to set up NSUL and Project Rachel display table for parish events such as youth group presentation (pro-life brochures/books, fetal models and animations, etc.). If you so wish, you may wish them to give a brief parish address after Mass to invite parishioner participation.

Supporting the above items can foster a culture of life for families and youth, and can protect them from wandering into the falsities promulgated by our current secular culture. It also invites those who are suffering from the effects of participating in abortion to draw closer to our Lord for healing.
